Educational objectives	Through the deepening and completion of the musical studies completed, it aims to provide advanced skills in the field of jazz performance and improvisation. In particular, the course aims to expand the knowledge of those who, already in possession of the qualifications required for admission, intend to specialize with the acquisition of further and specific professional skills through technical-interpretative study, of the repertoire for solo instrument and in <i>ensemble</i> , and specifically through: the technical-instrumental enrichment, the analytical-interpretative deepening, the deepening of the historical-stylistic knowledge of the main authors, the acquisition of an appropriate ability to listen and to relate with the other instruments of <i>ensemble</i> , participation in competitions, musical performances e <i>stages</i> .
